

GEORGE HULEN, D.D.S., :

It is hereby stipulated between George Hulen, D.D.S., personally and by his attorney, George Kotsonis, and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:


1. That George Hulen is duly licensed to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin and that his license bears #4000177 and was granted on August 28, 1944.
2. That an investigation of Dr. Hulen is pending before the Dentistry Examining Board under investigative file numbers 81 Dent 10, 81 Dent 17, 81 Dent 29, and 81 Dent 33.
3. That the investigation of Dr. Hulen involves allegations of incompetence, negligent applications of the principles of dentistry, and practicing or attempting to practice while the ability to perform services is impaired by alcohol.
4. That Dr. Hulen is currently undergoing treatment for alcoholism.
5. That Dr. Hulen is not currently engaged in the practice of dentistry.
6. That Dr. Hulen hereby freely and voluntarily agrees to retire from the practice of dentistry entirely effective the date of the Dentistry Examining Board Order adopting this Stipulation.
7. That Dr. Hulen hereby agrees not to renew his license to practice dentistry on the renewal date of September 30, 1983, or at any time subsequent to that date, without first complying with the following terms and conditions:
 - a. That in the event Dr. Hulen wishes to resume the active practice of dentistry he will inform the Dentistry Examining Board of his intention at least ninety (90) days prior to any anticipated resumption.
 - b. That prior to resuming the active practice of dentistry, Dr. Hulen agrees to appear before the Dentistry Examining Board and demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Board his fitness to practice under his license.

the right to declare the terms of this Stipulation null and void and restores the parties to their respective positions as they existed at the time of the execution of this Stipulation.



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- c. That at the time of his appearance before the Board and prior to his resumption of the active practice of dentistry, Dr. Hulen will present to the Board evidence that he has received treatment for his alcoholic condition. Such evidence shall include a statement from Dr. Hulen's treatment counselor and/or physician indicating that Dr. Hulen's condition will not prevent him from practicing safely and effectively as a dentist.
- d. That, in the event Dr. Hulen's condition requires on-going treatment, Dr. Hulen agrees to allow his treating physician and/or counselor to submit quarterly reports to the Board regarding his treatment program and condition. It shall be Dr. Hulen's responsibility to ensure these reports are submitted to the Board on a timely basis.
- e. That prior to the resumption of the active practice of dentistry, Dr. Hulen agrees to take a practical examination in orthodontics given by two licensed orthodontists approved by the Board. Following these examinations Dr. Hulen shall submit to the Board a statement from each orthodontist certifying that Dr. Hulen is competent to practice orthodontics.

8. That in consideration of Dr. Hulen's voluntary agreement to retire from the practice of dentistry, the Dentistry Examining Board shall terminate all pending investigations and no formal Complaints will issue. This action by the Dentistry Examining Board is taken without prejudice, and the Dentistry Examining Board reserves the right to reopen any pending investigations if Dr. Hulen fails to comply with any term of this Stipulation. This Stipulation shall not affect the ability of the Board to investigate and prosecute any activity engaged in by Dr. Hulen not presently under investigation.

9. That violation of any of the conditions specified in the Stipulation constitutes a basis for disciplinary action by the Dentistry Examining Board.

10. This Stipulation, if adopted by the Dentistry Examining Board, shall become effective immediately upon the issuance of the written Order by said Board.

11. It is expressly understood by the parties hereto that the terms agreed hereto and the admissions made in this Stipulation are intricately related to each other and are therefore made contingent upon the acceptance of this Stipulation in its entirety by the Dentistry Examining Board. Failure to accept this Stipulation in its entirety gives the parties hereto
