The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Richard C. Schultz, hereinafter the Respondent, is duly licensed under the provisions of Chapter 455, Wisconsin Statutes, to practice as a licensed psychologist in the State of Wisconsin.
2. That the Respondent has been licensed to practice psychology since November 10, 1972, when his license, #457, was granted.
3. That the Respondent's address is 1509 Tarragon Drive, Madison, Wisconsin 53716.
4. That in 1973 the Respondent provided psychological services to Patient A. Patient A was a minor at the time.
5. That the Respondent saw Patient A for approximately 7 sessions over a period of several months.

6. That the course of therapy recommended by the Respondent to Patient A fell below minimally acceptable standards.

7. That the Respondent has cooperated fully with the Board's investigation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Board has jurisdiction to take disciplinary action against the Respondent pursuant to Chapter 455, Stats.

Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. That the Respondent shall be and hereby is reprimanded.

2. That the Respondent is ordered to pay the costs of the action to the Department of Regulation and Licensing within 30 days of the date of this order. Costs are assessed in the amount of \$550.00.

The rights of a party aggrieved by this Decision to petition the Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth on the attached "Notice of Appeal Information."

It is hereby stipulated between Richard C. Schultz, Ph.D. personally on his own behalf and Michael J. Berndt, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows that:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation of Schultz's licensure by the Division of Enforcement (88 PSY 032). Schultz consents to the resolution of this investigation by stipulation and without the issuance of a formal complaint.


2. Schultz understands that by the signing of this Stipulation he voluntarily and knowingly waives his rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against him, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by clear, satisfactory and convincing evidence; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to call witnesses on his behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify himself; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to him under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

3. Schultz agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Psychology Examining Board.

4. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings.

5. If the Board accepts the terms of this Stipulation, the parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties.

6. As a prerequisite of this Stipulation, Schultz underwent a psychological assessment by a mutually agreeable therapist. The assessment was reviewed by the attorney for the Complainant and the Board Advisor, Dr. Rebecca Bardwell. The assessment found no reason to believe that Schultz is unable to practice psychology in a safe and competent manner. All costs of the assessment were paid by the Respondent.



7. The Division of Enforcement joins Schultz in recommending the Psychology Examining Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

8. The attorney for the Complainant and the Board Advisor may address the Board in closed session, without the presence of the Respondent, to answer questions regarding this agreement and to speak in favor of this agreement.
