

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board, having met on May 21, 1992, and having received and considered a Stipulation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein;



NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The attached Stipulation is approved and adopted by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
2. Robert R. Stocker, D.O., shall surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin effective on the date of this Order.
3. Robert R. Stocker, D.O., shall not practice or attempt to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin on or after the date of this Order.
4. Robert R. Stocker, D.O., shall not make reapplication for licensure at any time in the future.
5. The pending investigations, investigative files 84 MED 30, 86 MED 17, 88 MED 409, 89 MED 262, 89 MED 398, 90 MED 470 and 91 MED 260, shall be and hereby are closed and no formal actions will be commenced as a result of these investigations.

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STIPULATION

It is hereby stipulated between Robert R. Stocker, D.O., personally, and by his attorney, Judith P. Sullivan; and Gilbert C. Lubcke, attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

1. Robert R. Stocker, D.O., 1005 North Lake Road, Oconomowoc, Wisconsin 53006, is a physician duly licensed and currently registered to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, license #10946. Dr. Stocker's current registration expires on 11/1/93.
2. Dr. Stocker is presently 73 years of age. He has been retired from the practice of medicine since he suffered a ruptured aortic aneurysm on 1/22/90 and does not intend to return to the practice of medicine and surgery at any time in the future.
3. Investigations of Dr. Stocker are pending before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board, investigative files 84 MED 30, 86 MED 17, 88 MED 409, 89 MED 262, 89 MED 398, 90 MED 470 and 91 MED 260.
4. Dr. Stocker, solely in consideration of the present state of his health and of his retirement from the practice of medicine, and because of extensive legal costs and fees that would otherwise be incurred, hereby surrenders his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin effective on the date of the Order of the Medical Examining Board accepting this Stipulation, and further agrees that he will not make reapplication for licensure at any time in the future.
5. Dr. Stocker will not practice or attempt to practice medicine or surgery in the State of Wisconsin after the surrender of his license.
6. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board, upon acceptance of the terms of this Stipulation, will close the pending investigations identified in paragraph 3 of this Stipulation and no formal action will be commenced as a result of these investigations.
7. The parties to this proceeding waive all costs.
8. The Medical Examining Board may enter an Order not inconsistent with the terms of this Stipulation.
9. The parties to this Stipulation and the Board Advisor, Dr. Mark A. Hughes, may appear before the Medical Examining Board in support of this Stipulation.

10. If any term of this Stipulation is not accepted by the Medical Examining Board, then no term of this Stipulation will be binding in any manner on any party, and the matter will be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further investigation.
