ORDER MODIFYING THE LIMITED LICENSE

On September 25, 1991, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin was suspended for a period of five years, with the suspension stayed conditioned upon compliance with certain limitations on the license. Among these were that respondent participate in a recognized program for the treatment of chemical dependency, including participation in a program of random witnessed monitoring of his blood and/or urine for controlled substances and alcohol on at least a weekly basis.

By letter dated December 29, 1993, respondent requested that the frequency of required screens be reduced to once per month. Dr. Rowe's request was supported by Dr. David G. Benzer, Director of the McBride Center of Milwaukee Psychiatric Hospital. Dr. Rowe appeared before the board in support of his petition on January 20, 1994, and the board considered the matter on that date.

Based upon Dr. Rowe's petition and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 6 of the Final Decision and Order of the Medical Examining Board in the above-captioned matter dated September 25, 1991, is hereby modified to read as follows:

6. Dr. Rowe shall supply, on at least a twice per month basis, random monitored urine or blood specimens within 24 hours of a request for said specimen made by the supervising physician or his designee. The supervising physician or his designee shall determine whether the specimen shall be a urine specimen or a

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blood specimen or both. Collection of these specimens shall be observed and verified by persons designated by the supervising physician. Collection and all testing of specimens shall be the responsibility of Dr. Rowe or his health insurer.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other terms and conditions of the board's September 25, 1991, Order shall remain in full force and effect.
