The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Vali Kiaie (D.O.B. 4/04/53) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a dentist (license # 3504). This license was first granted on July 2, 1985.
2. Respondent's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 325 West Nokomis Court, Fox Point, WI 53217. Respondent is engaged in the general practice of dentistry.
3. During 1998 Respondent received shipments of controlled substances (hydrocodone and diazepam) at his residence address. Respondent did not maintain controlled substance records required by 21 CFR, section 1304.
  1. Respondent dispensed the hydrocodone as follows:
    - a. to an aunt in Germany,

- b. to a sister in Iran,
- c. to his mother and wife following dental procedures,
- d. to himself for back and ear pain.

1. Respondent dispensed the diazepam to his father for "sleep" problems.

6. Respondent also ordered controlled substances from a distributor using the DEA registration number of another dental practitioner.

7. Following a DEA inquiry Respondent surrendered his controlled substance prescribing privileges.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct described above, Vali Kiaie is subject to disciplinary action against his license to practice as a dentist in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 447.07(3)(a), (f) and (L), and Wis. Adm. Code sec. DE 5.02(6), (16) and (20) .

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that :

1. Vali Kiaie is REPRIMANDED for his unprofessional conduct.

2. The license of Respondent to practice as a dentist in the state of Wisconsin is LIMITED, in that Respondent shall not order, possess, dispense, prescribe or administer controlled substances, or re-apply for DEA registration until further order of the Board.

3. Respondent shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing within thirty days of the date of this Order the costs of the investigation and prosecution of this action in the sum of Four Hundred Dollars.

1. The rights of a party aggrieved by this Decision to petition the Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth on the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".

5. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
