ORDER REINSTATING FULL LICENSURE

On December 1, 1997, the Physical Therapist Affiliated Credentialing Board issued its *Order Adopting Stipulation* in the above-captioned matter. The Order finds that Ms. Recer's application for a license to practice as a physical therapist in Wisconsin reflects that she practiced physical therapy in this state prior to receiving a license. The Order requires Ms. Recer to complete not fewer than 12 hours of continuing education in the area of ethics for health care providers, and provides that failure to complete the required education would result in suspension of the license until the requirement is met. On December 16, 1998, Ms. Recer's license was suspended for failure to fulfill the educational requirement.

On February 29, 2000, the Physical Therapist Affiliated Credentialing Board considered Ms. Recer's *Petition seeking the Issuance of an Unconditional Physical Therapy License and Vacation of the December 1, 1997 Order of Reprimand*. At that time, the board also considered evidence of Ms. Recer's having completed the educational requirement required by the December 1, 1997 Order. Based upon the petition and upon other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Mary E. Recer, PT, to practice physical therapy in Wisconsin, be and hereby is, reinstated. All limitations on the license are terminated and Ms. Recer is restored to full licensure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that based on Ms. Recer's having practiced physical therapy in Wisconsin prior to becoming licensed to engage in that practice, Ms. Recer's petition to have the reprimand ordered by the board's December 1, 1997 Order vacated be, and hereby is, denied.
