ORDER ADOPTING STIPULATION

Applicant

Kathy A. Koebler filed an application for registration as a massage therapist or bodyworker in Wisconsin. The information received in the application process reflects that the applicant was convicted on September 16, 1999 of a felony - theft by virtue of employment - and was placed on five years probation.

The department and applicant have entered into a Stipulation by which the department agreed to issue, and applicant agreed to accept a limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration subject to specified conditions. Based upon the Stipulation and information of record herein, it is ORDERED as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Kathy A. Koebler is granted a limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Kathy A. Koebler shall file with the department quarterly reports within 5 days before or after the following dates:

August 1, 2000

November 1, 2000

February 1, 2001

May 1, 2001

August 1, 2001

November 1, 2001

February 1, 2002

May 1, 2002

August 1, 2002

November 1, 2002

February 1, 2003

May 1, 2003

August 1, 2003

November 1, 2003

February 1, 2004

May 1, 2004

2. Each report shall include:

a. The name, address and telephone number of applicant and name, address and telephone number of applicant's employer.

b. A statement from the applicant's probation officer acknowledging that there has been no violation of terms of probation by signing and dating each quarterly report.

3. Applicant Kathy A. Koebler shall comply with all terms of probation imposed upon her and make arrangements with her probation officer to notify the department immediately of any violation of

probation terms.

4. After completing probation, Applicant Kathy A. Koebler shall immediately provide the department with documentation that she has successfully completed all terms of her probation requirements.

5. This limitation may be removed no earlier than May 1, 2002 and only subsequent to a written request to the department on or after that date which also includes the report as required in this Order.

6. Failure by applicant Kathy A. Koebler to timely comply with the terms of this limitation shall result in the suspension of her limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration without further notice or hearing or other proceedings.

7. Any further criminal conviction (excluding DWI or OWI) shall result in the suspension of applicant Kathy A. Koebler's limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration without further notice or hearing or other proceedings.
