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MEMORANDUM AND ORDER ON SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

An informal settlement conference was conducted in the above-captioned matter before the Land Surveyor Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors on November 11, 1999. The purpose of the conference was to provide interested parties with an opportunity to discuss allegations received pertaining to the practice of Mr. Miller as a land surveyor, and to attempt to reach a fair and consensual resolution of the matter.

Mr. Miller appeared in person and without legal counsel. Others present included James E. Rusch, professional member of the Land Surveyor Section, acting as a committee of one; Charles J. Howden, attorney for the Department of Regulation & Licensing, Division of Enforcement; and Wayne Austin, the board's legal counsel.

The parties orally presented their respective positions regarding the matter to the committee, and the committee deliberated on a possible disposition of the matter. The committee thereafter presented a proposed Stipulation for Mr. Miller's consideration, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Stipulation was ultimately executed by Mr. Miller, Mr. Howden, and John Margitan, Chairman of the Land Surveyor Section.

Based upon the proceedings at the conference, and upon the Stipulation of the parties, the board enters the following order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(a) The license of Gregg E. Miller, R.L.S., shall be suspended for a period of 30 days, commencing 10 days from the date hereof.

(b) Mr. Miller's license shall be limited to require that within six months of the date hereof, Mr. Miller shall complete training in the use of the Eaglepoint surveying program, and shall complete at least 16 hours of education and training in the legal aspects of land surveying.

(c) Following the period of suspension, Mr. Miller shall complete a new plat of survey for the DeHaan parcel, and shall complete a new certified survey map to replace CSM 2543.

(d) For a period of six months following the period of suspension, Mr. Miller shall arrange for another registered land surveyor to review all survey maps prepared by him, and the reviewing land surveyor shall certify that he or she has reviewed each such survey map and has reviewed any recommended revisions thereto. At the end of the six month review period, Mr. Miller shall be responsible for submission to the land surveyor section of a report by the reviewing land surveyor evaluating Mr. Miller's current ability to practice land surveying in a competent manner.
