The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Eugene A. Ambrose (D.O.B. 01/26/30) is duly licensed to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin (license #4001381). This license was first granted on June 28, 1958.
2. Dr. Ambrose's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board is 4716 Green Bay Rd, Kenosha, WI 53144.
3. The Department of Regulation and Licensing Division of Enforcement has received allegations that at least on June 1, 1998, Dr. Ambrose maintained an unsanitary practice and procedures.
4. Dr. Ambrose contests the allegations set forth in paragraph 3, above, but in resolution of this matter consents to the issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to §447.07(3), Wis. Stats.
2. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to §§227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
3. The conduct described above constitutes a basis for discipline under Wis. Stats. §§447.07(3)(a) and (f) and Wis. Admin. Code § DE 5.02(1) and (5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

A. The license of Eugene A. Ambrose (#4001381) shall be LIMITED as follows:

1. Within six (6) months from the date of this order Dr. Ambrose shall submit acceptable documentation of successful completion of the May 19-20, 2000 course entitled "Annual Training - Dental Occupations and Safety" sponsored by Northwest Technical College Center for Business, Green Bay, Wisconsin; or acceptable documentation of successful completion of other training acceptable to the Board. To be acceptable, the course(s) or training shall be pre-approved by a member or designated agent of the Dentistry Examining Board.

Acceptable documentation shall include certification from the sponsoring organization as well as a statement signed by Dr. Ambrose verifying that he attended the course in its entirety. Dr. Ambrose shall be responsible for all costs associated with attending any course in compliance with this paragraph.

2. Dr. Ambrose shall appear before the Dentistry Examining Board following completion of the course work referenced in paragraph 1, above, in order to review with the Board his current sanitation and infection control procedures. The Board shall notify Dr. Ambrose in writing of the date and time of this appearance.

3. Respondent shall permit random unannounced inspections of his dental offices to evaluate the sanitation and infection control procedures in use. These inspections will be performed by an individual selected by the Dentistry Examining Board. At least two [2] inspections shall be conducted within one year from the effective date of this Order. The Board or its designee shall determine the dates on which the inspections will be conducted. The individual conducting the inspections will file a written report following each inspection with the Board.

4. Dr. Ambrose shall pay the professional fees and expenses of the individual selected by the Board to conduct inspections pursuant to this Order. Payment shall be made within thirty [30] days from the date upon which a statement for fees and expenses are mailed to Respondent.

5. Dr. Ambrose shall successfully pass any and all inspections conducted pursuant to this Order.

**6. In the event that Dr. Ambrose fails to timely and fully comply with the requirements set forth above, his Wisconsin license to practice dentistry shall be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until otherwise ordered by the Board.**

B. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the Board as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order, including receiving payment of costs and forfeitures, as well as coordinating all requests for approval of education.
