#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. David A. Revels, dba American Eagle Security Services herein (Applicant) whose mailing address is 2309 1 10th Street, Akron, Ohio 44314 holds a limited private detective agency license, number 15790 which was issued by the State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) under a Stipulation and Order for issuance of a limited private detective agency license, a copy of which is annexed hereto.
- 2. The Order for issuance of a limited private detective agency license includes the following provisions:
  - "1. Applicant shall immediately provide a current surety bond or Certificate of Insurance for American Eagle Security Services and a completed Form #1482 (STATEMENT CONCERNING LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCIES) signed by the authorized insurance company representative."
- "3. Applicant's private detective agency license shall be LIMITED to require submission of acceptable documentation of current comprehensive general liability insurance or surety bond for American Eagle Security Services every six months to the Department Monitor."
- "4. In the event that applicant fails to timely comply with paragraph 3, above, the private detective agency license SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until applicant has complied with the terms of this Order."
- 3. The applicant has failed to file with the department the spring, 2000 bond, certificate or form as of June 21, 2000

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

A. Applicant has not met the conditions in the Order that he file with the department acceptable documentation of current comprehensive general liability insurance or surety bond for American Eagle Security Services every six months to the Department Monitor.

B. The Department has authority to issue the following Order under Chapter 440, Stats., and the provisions in the Stipulation and Order for issuance of a limited private detective agency license.

### **ORDER**

Now, Therefore, It is ordered that the limited private detective agency license, number 15790 of David A. Revels, dba American Eagle Security Services, is SUSPENDED and the applicant shall cease and desist from acting as a private detective agency and from engaging in practice as a private detective in Wisconsin.

It is further ordered that Applicant shall have an opportunity to challenge the accuracy of the information contained in the Findings of Fact, above by submitting information to the Administrator, Division of Business Licensure and Regulation, P.O. Box 8935, Madison WI 53708-8935 within 10 days after the date of signing, below.

It is further ordered that suspension of the applicant's limited private detective agency license shall become effective on the tenth day after the date of signing, below.

It is further ordered that applicant shall immediately return the wallet size limited private detective agency license and wall certificate to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Attention: Marlene Maly, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.
