The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Corey Wilson and Charlene Wilson-Durr, 1925 W. Hampton Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53209, are listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owners of a duly licensed barbering and cosmetology establishment in the State of Wisconsin, known under the trade name, Black and Proud Beauty Salon.
2. Black and Proud Beauty Salon, 1925 W. Hampton Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53209, is licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the State of Wisconsin (license #80-26296). This license was first granted on March 21, 1997 and is current through June 30, 2001.
3. As owners of a licensed establishment, Corey Wilson and Charlene Wilson-Durr were at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code, chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
4. On exact dates unknown, but beginning at least on April 19, 1999 and continuing on through at least July 7,

2000, there was no licensed manager working at Black and Proud Beauty Salon. The previous licensed manager, Gregory E. Jewell, resigned from his position at the establishment as of April 1999. A letter from Mr. Jewell to the Department of Regulation and Licensing is attached and marked as **State's Exhibit 1**.

5. On July 7, 2000, the Department of Regulation and Licensing conducted an on-site inspection of the establishment and determined that there was a person, known as Christopher Martin, (AKA Christopher Paul) working at the establishment and providing barbering and cosmetology service to the public.

6. At no time relevant to this action, did Mr. Martin have a barbering and cosmetology license in the State of Wisconsin.

7. On July 7, 2000, the Department of Regulation and Licensing observed that the license of Yolanda Eason (#82-74240) was posted at the establishment and she was identified as the manager of the establishment.

8. At no time relevant to this action, did Ms. Eason hold a barbering and cosmetology manager's license in the State of Wisconsin.

9. At no time relevant to this action, did Corey Wilson or Charlene Wilson-Durr hold a valid and current Wisconsin barbering and cosmetology manager's license in the State of Wisconsin.

10. Beginning on or about September 2000, the Black and Proud Beauty Salon was closed and has not been reopened since then.

11. In resolution of these proceedings, Ms. Wilson-Durr and Corey Wilson consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in the paragraphs above, Charlene Wilson-Durr and Corey Wilson, d/b/a Black and Proud Beauty Salon, are in violation of secs. 454.04(1)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04(1) and §§ BC 3.02 (1) and §§ BC 3.02 (1) (a) and by the conduct referred to above, they are subject to disciplinary action against their establishment license, pursuant to sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Charlene Wilson-Durr and Corey Wilson shall **SURRENDER** their barbering and cosmetology license in the State of Wisconsin (license #80-26296). The respondents shall immediately return all license cards, certificates and/or other indicia of licensure to the Board. Should Charlene Wilson-Durr or Corey Wilson reapply for licensure in Wisconsin, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, a license may be issued.

This Order shall become effective on the date of its signing.
