The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Body & Sol, 630 South Street, Green Lake, WI 54941, is duly licensed as a manicuring establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #1697). This license was first granted on June 21, 2000.
2. Karlene Janes, PO Box 113, Green Lake, WI, is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Body & Sol. As owner, Ms. Janes was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On exact dates unknown, but at least on June 20, 2000, Body & Sol operated as a manicuring establishment without an establishment permit. When notified of this violation, Ms. Janes promptly filed an application and licensed her establishment.
4. In resolution of this matter, Ms. Janes consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent establishment, by the conduct referred to in ¶3, above, has violated sec. 454.08(1)(b) and 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Adm. Code §BC 3.01(1).

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ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

1. Karlene Janes shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of ONE THOUSAND dollars (\$1,000.00).
2. *Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:*

3. Payment shall be submitted on the following schedule:
 - a. Payment #1: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the first month following the effective date of this order.
 - b. Payment #2: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the second month following the effective date of this order.
 - c. Payment #3: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the third month following the effective date of this order.
 - d. Payment #4: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the fourth month following the effective date of this order.
 - e. Payment #5: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the fifth month following the effective date of this order.
 - f. Payment #6: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the sixth month following the effective date of this order.
 - g. Payment #7: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the seventh month following the effective date of this order.
 - h. Payment #8: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the eighth month following the effective date of this order.
 - i. Payment #9: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the ninth month following the effective date of this order.
 - j. Payment #10: Shall be made on or before the 15th day of the tenth month following the effective date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that Ms. Janes fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license of Body & Sol (#1697) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Ms. Janes has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
