The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Anna Geiger Electrolysis, 3602 Atwood Drive, Madison, WI 53714, is duly licensed as a electrolysis establishment in the State of Wisconsin (license #70-237). This license was first granted on May 30, 1986.
2. Anna M. Maas is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Ann Geiger Electrolysis. The last known address for Anna M. Maas in the Department of Regulation records is 3602 Atwood Drive, Madison, WI 53714.
3. Anna M. Maas is a licensed electrologist in the State of Wisconsin (license # 84-47). Ms. Mass's license was first granted on May 17, 1968.

4. On July 1, 1997, the electrology establishment license for Anna Geiger Electrolysis expired and was not renewed until February 29, 2000.
5. On June 30, 1997, the electrologist license for Anna M. Maas expired and was not renewed until February 18, 2000.
6. On February 11, 2000, the Department of Regulation conducted an unannounced inspection of the establishment in response to a complaint filed by a customer alleging unsanitary conditions at the establishment.
7. During the inspection by the Department, the respondent admitted that she continued to practice electrology at the establishment after her license had expired. The establishment continued to provide services to the public after its license had expired. Ms. Geiger indicated that she did not renew the licenses because she had a Department of Revenue tax lien restriction and presumed that her licenses would be denied.
8. Within two weeks after the inspection and notice of violation, Ms. Mass renewed her electrologist license and the establishment license.
9. As the owner, Ms. Maas was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
10. In resolution of this matter, ANNA M. MAAS, consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

By the conduct referred to in the paragraphs above, ANNA M. MAAS, d/b/a Anna Geiger Electrolysis violated the Wis. Stat. 454.04 (1) ( c), Wis. Stats. 454. 08 and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04 (1) and BC 3.02 (3)

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that ANNA M. MAAS, d/b/a Anna Geiger Electrolysis shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of **ONE THOUSAND** dollars (**\$1,000.00**). Payment shall be submitted within 12 months from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that in the event ANNA M. MAAS fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the establishment license and of Anna Geiger Electrolysis (70-237) and the electrologist license of Anna M. Maas, (84-47) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
