MODIFICATION OF ORDER

On February 13, 1996, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the above-captioned matter. Among the terms and conditions set forth in the board's order was that Mr. Kujawa enter and continue to participate in a rehabilitation, monitoring and treatment program acceptable to the board for the treatment of chemical abuse and dependency. Mr. Kujawa has requested that the *Final Decision and Order* be modified to discontinue the rehabilitation and treatment conditions and limitations contained therein. Mr. Kujawa has also requested an additional three month stay of suspension.

Based upon the foregoing and a review of the materials submitted by Mr. Kujawa in support of his request,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Gregory J. Kujawa, R.Ph., is hereby granted an additional three month stay of the suspension of license number 9508 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the February 13, 1996, *Final Decision and Order* be hereby modified to delete from the *Order* conditions 2b(1),(2),(3),(5)(a)(b) and (6) relating to the requirement of rehabilitation and treatment

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ORDERED that in all other respects, the previous orders of the board in this matter remain in full force and effect.
