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ORDER DENYING PETITION

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On January 23, 1997, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of its Order, the board accepted Dr. Roy's surrender of his license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin. The basis for the stipulated surrender of the license was the revocation of Dr. Roy's license in New Mexico.

By letter dated December 16, 1999, Dr. Roy petitioned the board for reinstatement of his license in Wisconsin. Dr. Roy appeared before the board on february 24, 2000, in support of his petition, and the board considered the matter on that date.

Based upon the petition, and upon all other information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition of Samir Roy, M.D., for reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin be, and hereby is, denied.

DISCUSSION

Under the board's Final Decision in this matter dated January 23, 1997, it was ordered that if the New Mexico medical board reinstates Dr. Roy's license without limitations, Dr. Roy may petition this board for reinstatement of his license in Wisconsin. While Dr. Roy is apparently continuing his efforts to become relicensed in New Mexico, he has thus far been unsuccessful. Accordingly, the board must deny reinstatement of his license in Wisconsin until he is able to persuade the New Mexico board that his license should be reinstated in that state.
