ORDER SUSPENDING LICENSE

On September 17, 1999, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was limited to require that within nine months following the date of the Order, Ms. Buggs complete not less than 24 hours of continuing education in the areas of stress/anger management, nursing ethics and medication passing.

On July 7, 2000, the board considered evidence that Ms. Buggs had failed to complete the required continuing education. Accordingly, and under paragraph 2 of the Order, which specifies that failure to comply shall result in immediate suspension of the license, it is ordered as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ms. Buggs' license to practice as an LPN in Wisconsin is hereby suspended until submission by her of satisfactory evidence that she has fully complied with the board's May 17, 1999, Final Decision and Order.
