ORDER
SUSPENDING LICENSE

On October 4, 1999, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order. Mr. Baker was ordered to pay a forfeiture of \$500.00 within 45 days, i.e. by November 18, 1999. The order contained the following provision:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Samuel Baker, Jr., fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, the manager license of Samuel Baker, Jr. (#23882) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent have [sic] complied with the terms of this Order.

According to information received by the board from department monitor Ted Nehring, Mr. Baker had not paid the forfeiture as of April 3, 2000. Mr. Baker requested in writing a 30-day extension of the time period for payment, and on December 7, 1999, Mr. Nehring acknowledged the letter and informed Mr. Baker that his payment should be received prior to the board's meeting in January 2000. On January 11, 2000, Mr. Nehring wrote to Mr. Baker requesting payment by January 20, 2000. On January 21, 2000, Mr. Nehring sent Mr. Baker a letter informing him that "Effective the date of this letter, the manager license (#23882) of Samuel Baker, Jr. is suspended."

IT IS ORDERED that manager license #23882 issued to Samuel Baker, Jr., is suspended as of January 21, 2000. Any practice of barbering and cosmetology or use of a manager's license by Samuel Baker, Jr., after January 21, 2000 will be considered operation without a license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Samuel Baker, Jr., shall return his manager's license to the department monitor, Ted Nehring, Department of Regulation and Licensing, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708, within ten days after the date of this order (below) or be subject to further discipline.

This suspension will be lifted upon payment of the required forfeiture.
