The Wisconsin Auctioneer's Board, having considered the record in the above captioned matter, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By an order dated September 25, 2000, the Auctioneer's Board issued a Final Decision and Order providing, among other things, that

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent Gene Finz shall pay partial costs of \$250.00 and a forfeiture in the amount of \$500.00, within 60 days of the date of this Order by making payment of the same to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

2. The September 25, 2000, provides, also, that,

Violation of any of the terms of this Order . . . may result in a summary suspension of the Respondent's license; the termination of the stay; the imposition of additional conditions and limitations; or the imposition of other additional discipline, including revocation of a certificate of registration.

3. Marlene K. Meyer is an employee of the Department whose job title is "Department Monitor" and whose responsibilities include receiving and processing the payment of costs and forfeitures that are ordered to be paid to the Department of regulation and Licensing.

4. On or about March 8, 2001, Marlene K. Meyer wrote t Gene J. Finz, stating that Finz had not paid the costs and forfeiture and requesting payment by March 18, 2001.

5. As of the date of this order, Gene J. Finz has not paid any part of the costs and forfeiture required by the September 25, 2000 Final Decision and Order of the Auctioneer's Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A. The State of Wisconsin Auctioneer's Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding under Chapter 480, Stats. and provisions in the September 25, 2000 Final Decision and Order of the Auctioneer's Board.

B. The Auctioneer Board ordered Gene J. Finz to pay costs pursuant to the authority in sec. 440.22 (2), Stats.

C. Under the requirements of sec. 440.22 (3), Stats., the Department may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to Gene J. Finz until Gene J. Finz has made payment under sec. 440.22 (2), Stats. in the full amount assessed, together with any accrued interest.

D. The State of Wisconsin Auctioneer's Board has authority to issue the following Order under Chapter 480 and sec. 440.22 (3), Stats., and the provisions in the September 25, 2000 Final Decision and Order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that license #52-1200 of Gene J. Finz as an auctioneer in the state of Wisconsin, is SUSPENDED INDEFINITELY until the respondent has made payment of costs and forfeitures in the full amount assessed, together with any accrued interest.
