The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Gayle M. Glynn, RN (DOB 03/11/54), is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice as a registered nurse (license #111412). This license was first granted on September 11, 1992.
2. Respondent's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 6901 East Lake Mead Boulevard, Las Vegas, NV 89156.
3. On or about October 9, 1998, the Nevada Board of Nursing imposed disciplinary action against the license of Respondent. The factual basis for the imposition of discipline against Respondent in Nevada involved diversion of narcotics. A true and correct copy of the Nevada Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order is attached to this document as Exhibit A.
4. Respondent consents to the issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order in resolution of this matter.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to ch. 441.07, Stats.
2. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation, pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Stats.
3. The conduct described above constitutes a basis for discipline under sec. 441.07(1)(c), Stats, and Wis. Admin. Code § N7.04, (1), (7) and (15).

**ORDER**

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board of Nursing ACCEPTS the SURRENDER of the license of Gayle M. Glynn (license #111412) to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should Ms. Glynn reapply for Wisconsin licensure, the Board may in its sole discretion determine whether, and under what terms and conditions, this license may be reissued.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
