The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department Secretary. The Department Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lisa Ann Olson, [921 350th Avenue, County Road E, Frederic, WI 54837] is not and was not at any time relevant to this action licensed to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin. Prior to coming to Wisconsin, Dr. Olson was at one time licensed to practice dentistry in the state of Michigan.
2. On exact dates unknown, but beginning in 1996 and continuing on through August 2001, Respondent engaged in the practice of dentistry in Frederic, Wisconsin.
3. Dr. Olson understands that she needs a license to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin. In resolution of this matter, Dr. Olson consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to sec. 440.21, Wis. Stats.
2. A license is required to practice Dentistry in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to sec. 447.03, Wis. Stats.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Respondent LISA ANN OLSON is ENJOINED and PROHIBITED as follows:

1. Respondent SHALL NOT PRACTICE OR OFFER TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY in the state of Wisconsin unless and UNTIL she obtains a license from the Dentistry Examining Board.
2. **Violation of the above-order may result in a forfeiture of up to \$10,000.00 for each offense, and each day of a continued violation constitutes a separate offense.**
3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
