On September 11, 2001, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed a petition by John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., requesting the board to reinstate a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated August 13, 1997. The board also reviewed correspondence dated August 28, 2001, from Schmitt's counselor, Robert L. Gordon, Jr., MA, MHA, CADCIII.

Based upon the board's review of the petition and the August 28, 2001 correspondence, the board finds that reinstating a stay of suspension of license #8852 to John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin would constitute a danger to the public health, safety and welfare. Accordingly:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., is denied a reinstated three month stay of the suspension of license #8852 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the suspension of John R. Schmitt, R.Ph., license #8852, to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin shall remain in effect for a minimum of one (1) year from the date of the signing of this order, and that as a precondition to petitioning the board for any further stay of suspension, the respondent shall demonstrate to the board full compliance with the terms and conditions of the *Order* for a period of one (1) year preceding the month in which a petition for further stay of suspension is filed.
