FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 5, 2000, the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, (Department), issued an Order Adopting Stipulation, (Order), granting a limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration to Kathy A. Koebler.
2. The applicant agreed to accept a limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration subject in part to the specified conditions set forth in paragraph 1 of the Order as follows:
 1. Kathy A. Koebler shall file with the department quarterly reports within 5 days before or after the following dates: August 1, 2000, November 1, 2000, February 1, 2001, May 1, 2001, August 1, 2001, November 1, 2001, February 1, 2002, May 1, 2002, August 1, 2002, November 1, 2002, February 1, 2003, May 1, 2003, November 1, 2003, February 1, 2004, May 1, 2004.
3. Paragraph two of the Order further provided as follows:
 2. Each report shall include:
 - a. The name, address and telephone number of applicant and name, address and telephone number of applicant's employer.
 - b. A statement from the applicant's probation officer acknowledging that there has been no violation of terms of probation by signing and dating each quarterly report.

4. Paragraph six of the Order further provided as follows:

6. Failure by applicant Kathy A. Koebler to timely comply with the terms of this limitation shall result in the suspension of her limited massage therapist or bodyworker registration without further notice or hearing or other proceedings.

5. Marlene Meyer is an employee of the Department whose job title is "Department Monitor" and whose responsibilities include receiving and monitoring reports from credential holders who hold a limited credential and who are required to file reports with the Department.

6. On July 2, 2002, Marlene Meyer wrote via email to Kimberly Nania, the Bureau of Health Service Professions Director for the Department, concerning Kathy A. Koebler stating:

"On August 6, 2001, I sent Ms. Koebler a letter informing her that she was delinquent on the report that was due on August 1, 2001. I gave her until August 17, 2001 to get that report in to me. On the 17th, I left her a message for her to call me. No return call. On the 29th, I left another message for her to call me. No return call. Since then 3 other reports should have been filed and there has been no contact from her at all.

Marlene"

7. As of the date of this decision Kathy A. Koebler has not filed the reports required by the Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The failure of Kathy A. Koebler to file a report within five days before or after August 1, 2001 and the failure to file subsequent reports constitute a failure to comply with the terms of the limitations in the Order.

2. The Department has jurisdiction in this proceeding under Wis. Stats., Chapter 440, Subchapter XI, and the provisions in the Order.

3. The Department has authority to issue the following Order in this proceeding under Wis. Stats., Chapter 440, Subchapter XI, and the provisions of the Order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of registration as a massage therapist or bodyworker, number 46-1885, issued to Kathy A. Koebler, is SUSPENDED.
