The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Mastercuts #4875, 5706 Durand Avenue, Racine, WI 53406, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license #19441). This license was first granted on December 19, 1988.
2. Regis Corporation, 7201 Metro Blvd., Minneapolis, MN 55439, is listed with the Department of Regulation and Licensing as the owner of Mastercuts #4875. As owner, Regis Corporation was and is at all times relevant to this action responsible for compliance with ch. 454, Stats. and Wisconsin Administrative Code chs. BC 2, 3 and 4.
3. On or about January 30, 2002, inspection of Mastercuts #4875 revealed the following:
 - a. Workstations at the establishment were not maintained in a clean and sanitary condition, as required by Wis. Admin. Code §BC 4.01(1);
 - b. Disinfectant was not being changed on a daily basis, as required by Wis. Admin. Code §BC 4.02(1); and
 - c. Cleaned contact equipment was being stored in an open container, in violation of Wis. Admin. Code §BC 4.02(3a)
4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

By the conduct referred to in ¶ 3, above, Regis Corporation, d/b/a Mastercuts #4875 violated sec. 454.15(2)(i), Stats. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 4.01(1), BC 4.02(1) and (3a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that

1. Respondent shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of THREE HUNDRED dollars (\$300.00). Payment shall be submitted within thirty [30] days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935

2. In the event Regis Corporation fails to timely pay the forfeiture set forth in ¶ 1 above, the establishment license of Mastercuts #4875 (license #19441) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

3. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
