On March 12, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Andrew P. Rice, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated September 21, 1999, and his request to discontinue group therapy. The board on March 12, 2002, granted a one-month stay of suspension and denied the requested modifications to the order.

On April 9, 2002, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed correspondence from Rice's therapist, Martin Ferrero, dated March 29, 2002, indicating that Rice had not attended therapy required by the *Order* since January 3, 2002, and that Ferrero had been informed by Rice that Rice would not be able to attend therapy until April 4, 2002, due to ongoing coaching commitments Rice had with his children's basketball program.

Based upon the board's review of Mr. Ferrero's correspondence and the board finding that no further petition for a stay has been filed with the board by Rice, the board finds that Rice is in violation of the *Order* and accordingly;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the license of Andrew P. Rice, R.Ph., to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin, license #9594, is SUSPENDED.
