ORDER GRANTING LIMITED LICENSE

On August 18, 2004, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board reviewed the application for medical licensure submitted by Abdelmoneim F. Eltomi, M.D. Based upon all of the information of record, the Board adopts and issues the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about January 23, 2004, Abdelmoneim F. Eltomi, M. D., submitted an application for a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin, pursuant to the reciprocity of his Missouri medical license.
2. Dr. Eltomi was previously granted a temporary license in Wisconsin in 2003.
3. Dr. Eltomi's current address is 4631 S. Atlantic Avenue, #8101, Ponce Inlet, Florida, 32127.
4. Dr. Eltomi received his medical degree from the Kase Elani Faculty of Medicine, Cairo University, Cairo, Egypt, in 1955.
5. Dr. Eltomi was issued a medical license in the state of Missouri based upon his successful passage of the Missouri State Board Exam on March 24, 1972.
6. The Missouri State Board Exam, which Dr. Eltomi passed with scores above 75%, did not include psychiatry, pharmacology and a clinical competence examination.
7. The Missouri State Board Examinations were not substantially equivalent to the Wisconsin State Board Examinations given in 1972 because the topics of psychiatry, pharmacology and clinical competence were not included.
8. Dr. Eltomi has practiced medicine, including direct patient care, teaching, and research in the United States for thirty five years. His medical practice has been primarily in psychiatry and neurology.
9. Dr. Eltomi has been licensed to practice medicine in Florida, Arizona, Indiana and Illinois.
10. In 1978, Dr. Eltomi obtained American Board Specialty - Psychiatry and Neurology, which included a clinical competency test.
11. Dr. Eltomi has not taken the USMLE, SPEX or PLAS examinations.
12. There is no reported disciplinary action against Dr. Eltomi by any state in which he has held licensure.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that the applicant, Abdelmoneim F. Eltomi, M.D., shall be granted a license to practice medicine in the state of Wisconsin on the basis of reciprocity. However, the license granted to Dr. Eltomi shall be LIMITED because the Missouri State Board exams were not substantially equivalent to the Wisconsin state board exams given in 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Eltomi's medical license shall limit his medical practice to the area of Psychiatry and Neurology.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this limitation shall be INDEFINITE in duration and shall be subject to modification, upon petition to the Board, only if Dr. Eltomi passes the USMLE, SPEX and/or PLAS examinations.

The action of the Board in granting this limited license is non-disciplinary.
