On Thursday, September 16, 2004, pursuant to the Order currently in effect against Kathleen (Frick) Molle, RN, the Board of Nursing considered the applicant's request for reinstatement of her license to practice as a registered nurse. Based upon all information of record herein, the Board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the petition of Kathleen (Frick) Molle, RN, (license #79558) for reinstatement of her nursing license is DENIED.

Applicant has not held current nursing licensure for over 5 years, and will require successful completion of a Board-approved refresher course in order to be considered for relicensure. As a prerequisite to obtaining the limited license required to complete a refresher course, the applicant shall submit a current AODA assessment (from a Board-approved evaluator) attesting to her fitness to return to practice as a registered nurse, together with acceptable documentation of at least three [3] months of sobriety. Information on refresher courses, assessment providers and documentation of sobriety is available through the Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8935, FAX (608)266-2264, telephone no. (608)261-3817, e-mail: department.monitor@drl.state.wi.us.

PLEASE NOTE that as this Order constitutes a denial of a license application, you have a right to a hearing on the denial if you file a request for hearing in accordance with the provisions of Ch. RL 1 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code. You may request a hearing within 45 calendar days after the mailing of this notice of denial. Your request must be submitted in writing to the Board of Nursing at: Department of Regulation and Licensing, 1400 East Washington Avenue, P.O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

The request must contain your name and address, the type of credential for which you have applied, a specific description of the mistake in fact or law that you assert was made in the denial of your credential, and a concise statement of the essential facts which you intend to prove at the hearing. You will be notified in writing of the Board of Nursing's decision. Under s. RL 1.08 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, a request for a hearing is denied if a response to a request for a hearing is not issued within 45 days of its receipt by the Board. Time periods for a petition for review begin to run 45 days after the Board has received a request for a hearing and has not responded.

This Order is effective upon the date of signing.
