On February 9, 2005, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed a petition by Triscari for reinstatement of a three month stay of suspension as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* ("Order") dated May 17, 2000. Evidence submitted by Triscari's treating physician indicated that a drug screen provided by Triscari on December 1, 2004, tested positive for oxazepam. Mr. Triscari provided a sample of a type of Chinese tea which he had been drinking at about the time that the December 1, 2004 drug screen was obtained. The sample of tea was assayed for the possible presence of a benzodiazepine. Triscari's treating physician informed the board in correspondence dated February 1, 2005, that the tea was positive for diazepam. Triscari's treating physician indicated that he counseled Triscari regarding this issue and that Triscari is no longer drinking this tea. Based upon review by the board:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Thomas M. Triscari, R.Ph., is denied a three-month stay of the suspension of license #10029 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin. Triscari must provide evidence to the Board of full compliance with the terms and conditions of the *Order* for a period of 3 months, (January, February and March, 2005) prior to re-petitioning the Board for a stay of suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Triscari shall henceforth utilize FirstLab Inc., for drug screening as required by paragraph 2b.(4) of the *Order*.
