PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”). The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. David M. Koskey, (DOB October 02, 1953) is duly licensed as a physician’s assistant in the state of Wisconsin (license #347). This license was first granted on March 11, 1983.
2. David M. Koskey’s most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board is 101 South Gibson Street, Medford, Wisconsin 54451.
3. At all times relevant to this action, David M. Koskey was working as a physician’s assistant at Medford Clinic, 101 South Gibson Street, Medford, Wisconsin.
4. An informal complaint received by the Medical Examining Board alleges David M. Koskey failed to document in the patient records prescriptions written for two patients during the time period of November 16, 2004 through December 29, 2004.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §448.02, and

is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. David M. Koskey, will, within 9 months of the date of this Final Decision And Order, take and complete 8 hours of Category 1 continuing education credits in medical record keeping and documentation. Each course attended in satisfaction of this Order must be preapproved by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board or its designee. David M. Koskey will be responsible for locating courses satisfactory to the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board and for obtaining the required approval of the courses from the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board or its designee. David M. Koskey will within 60 days of completion of this educational requirement file an affidavit with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board stating under oath that he has attended in its entirety each of the courses approved for satisfaction of this requirement along with supporting documentation of attendance from the sponsoring organizations. This affidavit and the supporting documentation of attendance will be filed with:

All certifications, affidavits or other documents required to be filed with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board will be deemed filed upon receipt by the Department Monitor.

2. David M. Koskey will be responsible for paying the full cost of attendance at these courses. David M. Koskey will not apply any of the continuing education credits earned in satisfaction of this Order toward satisfaction of his Wis. Stat. § 448.13 biennial training requirements.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

3. David M. Koskey shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00). Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

4. In the event David M. Koskey fails to timely pay costs as ordered or fails to comply with the ordered continuing education, David M. Koskey's license (#347) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until David M. Koskey has complied with the terms of this Order. The Board or its designee will remove the suspension, if provided with sufficient information that David M. Koskey is in compliance with the Order and that it is inappropriate for the suspension to remain in effect. The Board in its discretion may impose additional conditions and limitations for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

5. David M. Koskey is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Final Decision and Order.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
