PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. **Charles R. Bash**, date of birth 01/13/68, is duly licensed as a Private Security Person in the State of Wisconsin having license # 108-6336. This license was first granted to him on 12/18/97. Mr. Bash's last reported address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 4033 Curry Lane, Janesville, WI 53546.

2. Mr. Bash was convicted on February 21, 2003, in Green County Wisconsin of misdemeanor Theft in a Business Setting for the theft of between \$460.00 and \$750.00 in traffic forfeitures from the Albany Police Department when he worked for the Police Department in 1998.

3. Mr. Bash failed to report his conviction to the Department within 48 hours after the judgment of conviction.

4. On or about April 5, 2005, Mr. Bash completed a Firearms Certification of Proficiency –Renewal and answered “no” to the question:

a. Has the owner or employee named on p.1 ever been convicted of a misdemeanor or a felony?

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Mr. Bash's conviction for Theft in a Business Setting is substantially related to the practice of Private Security and it is a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2).

3. Mr. Bash's failure to report his conviction is a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2) and Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b).

4. Mr. Bash's false answer on his April 5, 2005, application is a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(17).

## ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That Respondent, **Charles R. Bash** license # 108-6336, be and hereby is **REPRIMANDED**.

2. That Respondent shall pay **COSTS** in this matter in the amount of fourteen hundred dollars (\$1,400.00) within days of the date of this Order.

3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. In its discretion the Department may, in the alternative, impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as set forth above, Respondent's license **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

4. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
