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ORDER DENYING STAY OF SUSPENSION

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On December 8, 2005, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that the suspension was stayed upon respondent's compliance with certain conditions and limitations on her license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program, that she participate in therapy at least once per week, and that she attend AA or NA on at least a weekly basis. Respondent was also required to participate in a drug screening program consisting of at least fifty-six screens per year.

On June 8, 2006, the board considered evidence that Ms. Larscheidt had not been in compliance with the limitations on her license by showing up to her employment intoxicated. A blood test done at her place of employment is proof of non-compliance. Accordingly, the board revokes the stay of suspension. The suspension is hereby reinstated effective immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Jean Larscheidt, RN, shall remain suspended indefinitely.
