PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Stacey A. Kinchen (D.O.B. 9/11/59) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a professional nurse (license # 147651). This license was first granted on 6/1/04.
2. On 4/8/05, Respondent signed an agreement to surrender his nursing license in Mississippi, to resolve a disciplinary investigation. The facts underlying the matter are that Respondent, while employed as a nurse at St. Dominic/Jackson Memorial Hospital, Jackson, Mississippi, in the months preceding October, 2003, had fraudulently obtained a computer access code of his supervisor to gain access to the timekeeping records of his employer; he then altered the time records for himself and his spouse (who also worked at the facility), for the purpose of obtaining money and additional paid vacation time. He later repaid the hospital \$6,000 in restitution and was not prosecuted criminally.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

By the conduct described above, respondent is subject to disciplinary action against his license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(b) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code § N 7.04(1), (7), and (13).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that :

1. Stacey A. Kinchen, RN, is REPRIMANDED for his unprofessional conduct in this matter.
2. The license of Stacey A. Kinchen to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin is LIMITED as follows: Respondent shall provide all future nursing employers with a copy of this Order before engaging in any nursing employment; his current employers shall be provided with a copy forthwith.
3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit any payment of the Costs as set forth below, Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall pay the costs of investigating and prosecuting this matter, in the amount of \$350, within 45 days of this Order.
