PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Rassan M. Tarabein, M.D. (DOB 6/18/59), is duly licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (license #20-35441). This license was first granted on May 27, 1994. Dr. Tarabein's specialty is neurology.
2. Dr. Tarabein's latest address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 990 Marvell Lane, Daphne, AL 36526.
3. On or about October 27, 2004, the State of Alabama, Medical Licensure Commission imposed disciplinary action against Dr. Tarabein and imposed various limitations on his Alabama license. The factual basis for the imposition of discipline against Dr. Tarabein in Alabama involved practice below standards and endangering patient health and wellbeing. A true and correct copy of the Alabama Stipulation and Consent Order is attached and incorporated by reference into this document as Exhibit A.
4. Respondent consents to the issuance of the following Conclusions of Law and Order in resolution of this matter.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3) and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. The conduct described above constitutes a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § Med 10.02 (2)(q).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Wisconsin license of Rasan M. Tarabein, M.D. (license #20-35411) is LIMITED as provided for in Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3)(e) and as follows:

1. Dr. Tarabein is to maintain full and complete compliance with all terms, limitations, and conditions imposed against his medical license in the State of Alabama.
2. Dr. Tarabein shall compel the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners to submit quarterly reports, in a form acceptable to the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board, describing the status of his Alabama medical licensure together with documentation of his compliance with the terms of his probation in Alabama.
3. Dr. Tarabein may not practice medicine in Wisconsin unless he obtains approval from the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board as provided for in paragraph 4 of this order.
4. If Dr. Tarabein plans to practice medicine in Wisconsin he shall appear in person before the Board to answer any questions that the Board may have regarding that practice. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board may impose additional terms, limitations and conditions on any Wisconsin practice of Dr. Tarabein.
5. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the Board as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order, including receiving and coordinating all reports, petitions and requests for appearances before the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.
6. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, pay the costs of this proceeding in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

7. Dr. Tarabein may petition the Board for the end of limitations on his Wisconsin medical license when he can demonstrate that he possesses unlimited licensure in the State of Alabama.
8. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's certification or licensure pursuant to the procedures set forth in Wis Admin. Code Ch. RL 6. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions, terms, and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.
9. In the event the Respondent fails to pay the forfeiture or the costs as ordered the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED until the Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
10. This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
