PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Physical Therapist Affiliated Credentialing Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Anne M. Conway, P.T., (DOB 11/07/1955) is duly licensed as a physical therapist in the state of Wisconsin (license #24-1764). This license was granted on 07/27/1977.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Physical Therapists Affiliated Credentialing Board is 3911 Calverton Drive, Hyattsville, MD 20782.
3. On or about September 20, 2005, the Government of the District of Columbia Department of Health, Board of Physical Therapy imposed disciplinary action against Respondent for supervising and practicing with an unlicensed physical therapist who failed the licensure examination and who had been advised to cease practicing. A true and correct copy of the District of Columbia Settlement Agreement and Consent Order is attached and incorporated by reference into this document as [Exhibit A](#).

4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Physical Therapists Affiliated Credentialing Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.57, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 3, above, constitutes a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § PT 7.02(17).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Anne M. Conway, P.T. (license #24-1764), is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:
