### **PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Professional Engineering Section ("Section"). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Walter R. Wilcox, date of birth 01/07/59, is registered in the State of Wisconsin as a professional engineer license #6-26656. This license was first granted on 10/20/89.
2. Mr. Wilcox's last reported home address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing ("Department") is 1051 Nottingham Dr., Cedar Hill, TX 75104.
3. Mr. Wilcox is a principle in L.A. Fuess Partners, Inc., (firm) an engineering firm in Dallas Texas.
4. On or about December 16, 2005, the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers imposed discipline against Mr. Wilcox's engineering license and the engineering firm's license. The board action was based on findings that Mr. Wilcox and the firm practiced engineering in West Virginia without a license and for providing false information to the Board.
5. On or about December 16, 2005, Mr. Wilcox and the firm signed a Consent Order with the West Virginia State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.

Board of Registration for Professional Engineers regarding the unlicensed practice and for providing false information. The Cor Order provided that Mr. Wilcox and the firm pay civil penalties and administrative costs.

6. Additionally, Mr. Wilcox failed to notify the Department of the disciplinary actions that he received in West Virg

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Professional Engineers Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Arch Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 443.11 authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Respondent Walter R. Wilcox has violated:

a. Wis. Admin. Code §§ A-E 8.03(3)(a) and A-E 8.09(1) and Wis. Stat. § 443.11(1)(e) by violating state laws and administrative rules relating to the p of professional engineering;

b. Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 8.08(1) by failing to furnish the Professional Engineers Section with information had been disciplined in another state.

### ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

1. **Walter R. Wilcox**, license # 6-26656 be, and hereby is, **REPRIMANDED**.
