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ORDER DENYING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On January 26, 2006, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that the suspension was stayed upon respondent's compliance with certain conditions and limitations on her license. Included among these were that respondent call in daily for random drug screens, submit quarterly work and therapy reports.

On February 6, 2007, the board considered evidence that Ms. Peterson had not been in compliance with the limitations on her license by not calling in for her drug screens, not testing and failure to submit quarterly work and therapy reports as outlined in her Final Decision & Order dated January 26, 2006. Accordingly, the board revokes the stay of suspension. The suspension is hereby reinstated effective immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Stephanie Peterson, LPN, is suspended indefinitely.
