PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On November 1, 2007, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board reviewed Ernst J. Neumeyer's, D.C., petition for restoration of his license. Ernst Neumeyer's license was suspended indefinitely by the Board by Order dated November 30, 2006.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On November 30, 2006, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board issued an Order indefinitely suspending Ernst Neumeyer's license and imposing costs of \$250.00. The costs were due February 28, 2007, and payment was received on November 29, 2006.
2. On September 21, 2007, the Department of Regulation and Licensing received a letter from Ernst Neumeyer requesting the reinstatement of his license and an appearance before the Board.
3. On November 1, 2007, the Board considered his request for reinstatement. Based on the Board's review of the record, the Board finds that Ernst J. Neumeyer should be issued a limited license. Limitations are set to insure that the finances of his business are maintained in accordance with professional standards.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on its review of the testimony presented and the record in this case, and pursuant to its authority under, § 446.03, Wis. Stat., the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board decided that it will issue a limited license to Ernst J. Neumeyer when he meets specified requirements. His license will be limited because it is necessary due to the nature of the facts of the disciplinary matter.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, the suspension of Ernst J. Neumeyer's license is terminated and a limited license will be granted to him when he submits evidence to the Board that he has done all of the following:

1. Completed outstanding renewal requirements from the previous biennium.
2. Submitted an explanation or proposed accounting methods subject to Board approval.
3. Obtained a Board approved mentor.
4. Obtained a Board approved CPA.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, when the above noted conditions are completed, the Board will grant Ernst Neumeyer a license with the following limitations:

1. Ernst Neumeyer must submit to the Board satisfactory quarterly reports from his parole officer.
2. Ernst Neumeyer may not physically handle financial transactions.
3. A non-family member employee shall handle all payments.
4. Ernst Neumeyer may not evaluate or treat any patient outside of the Neumeyer Clinic.
5. Ernst Neumeyer must ensure that his billings are consistent with the number of patients he sees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, Ernst J. Neumeyer's license shall be limited for not less than one year.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Board reserves the right to impose any other limitations or restrictions on Ernst J. Neumeyer's license to protect the interest of the public.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT any violation of this Order shall constitute grounds for the suspension of Ernst J. Neumeyer's license without further hearing and without further Order of this Board, and said suspension shall be for an indefinite period of time.

Ernst J. Neumeyer must have all required information submitted to the Department Monitor for approval and compliance purposes. Noncompliance with this Order may result in a Summary Suspension.
