**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Amy T. Johnson, date of birth: 06/14/73, is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology practitioner having license #082 078055. This license was first granted on 12/04/98.
2. Ms. Johnson's most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing ("Department") is: 3669 South 79th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53220.
3. Ms. Johnson is currently employed at Neso's Village Cuts (#80 18936; granted: 05/04/81). Neso's Village Cuts current address on file with the Department is: 7212 West State Street, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin 53213.
4. On or about February 1, 2006, the Department received a newspaper article stating that a client had been bit by a dog at Neso's Village Cuts on November 23, 2005. A true and correct copy of the newspaper article is attached as Exhibit A, and is incorporated by reference into this document.
5. On or about May 9, 2006, an inspection of Neso's Village Cuts was conducted by a Department investigator. The May 9, 2006 inspection revealed that Ms. Johnson was operating a barbering and cosmetology booth

rental without first obtaining an establishment license and manager's license.

6. To date, Department records do not indicate that Ms. Johnson has obtained an establishment license or a manager's license.

7. In resolution of this matter, Amy T. Johnson consents to the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15.

2. The Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

3. Respondent Amy T. Johnson has violated:

Wis. Stat. §§ 454.08 (1)(b); 454.08(6) and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.04(1); 2.045(1); 3.01(1) and 3.02(1)(2)(b) by operating a booth rental without obtaining an establishment license and manager's license.

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Respondent is hereby **REPRIMANDED** for the violations set forth above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Respondent shall jointly and severally pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of **ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Respondent shall jointly and severally pay costs in this matter in the amount of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a down payment of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)** shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this order and two more payments of **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)** will be due (60) days from the previous payment until the full **ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00)** is paid. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event that Amy T. Johnson fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as set forth above, the barbering and cosmetology practitioner's license for Amy T. Johnson (#082 78055) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said costs has been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and their failure to pay the costs shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file 06 BAC 016, be and hereby is, closed as to Amy T. Johnson.
