PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. **Cheryl A. Strockis** is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Manager, having license # 81-24365. This license was first granted to her on 06/13/91. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Ms. Strockis is 172 W. Highland, Burlington, WI 53105.

2. **Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center** is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Establishment, having license # 80-26850. This license was first granted to it on 10/03/97. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for this establishment is Hwy. 50 E., Lake Geneva, WI 53147.

3. On August 16, 2006, an investigator from the Department of Regulation and Licensing performed an unannounced inspection at Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center. Prior to the inspection, the investigator had reviewed the Department's records for Grand Geneva which identified Brenda Steinke as the licensed barbering and cosmetology manager for the establishment. During the inspection, Cindi Schweitzer, the spa director, informed the Department investigator that Cheryl Strockis is the licensed barbering and cosmetology manager for the establishment and Brenda Steinke is no longer an

employee there.

4. During the August 16, 2006 inspection, Ms. Schweitzer informed the investigator that Cheryl Strockis, the licensed barbering and cosmetology manager, only worked at the salon approximately two days a week for about the last eight months. Ms. Schweitzer indicated that no other licensed manager had been employed by the establishment during that time.

5. At the close of the August 16, 2006 inspection, an Order to Correct was issued to Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center requiring the establishment to hire a full-time manager.

6. By letter dated September 20, 2006, Ms. Schweitzer notified the department that Ms. Strockis is now scheduled to work in the establishment 30 hours per week.

7. Pursuant to a follow-up request by the Department, Ms. Schweitzer submitted time sheets for Cheryl Strockis demonstrating that Ms. Strockis is now working full-time at the establishment.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Respondents **Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center** and **Cheryl Strockis** violated Wis. Stat. § 454.08(6) and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 3.02(1) and 1.01(7) by not having a full-time manager at Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center for approximately eight months.

3. Respondents **Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center** and **Cheryl Strockis** violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.06(5) by failing to notify the Department of the change in managers when Ms. Strockis became the manager for the establishment.

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. **Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center**, license # 80-26850, and **Cheryl Strockis**, license # 81-24365, shall jointly and severally pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$500.00 within 90 days of the date of this Order.

2. **Grand Geneva Spa & Sports Center**, license # 80-26850, and **Cheryl Strockis**, license # 81-24365, shall jointly and severally pay COSTS in the amount of \$625.00 within 90 days of the date of this Order.

3. Payment of the forfeiture and costs shall be made by **certified check or money order**, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may, in the alternative, impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondents fail to timely submit any payment as ordered, then the Respondents' licenses SHALL BE SUSPENDED without further notice or hearing until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.

5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file, 06 BAC 038 is hereby closed.
