PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jodi L. Roll, R.N., (DOB 12/28/61) is duly licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license #143030). This license was first granted on 3/8/04.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 550 Orion Trail, Madison, Wisconsin 53718.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a nurse at University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics, 600 North Highland Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin 53792.
4. On November 11, 2002, Respondent applied for her registered nurse licensure by endorsement by filing an application with the Board of Nursing.
5. On December 11, 2002, Respondent applied for and received a temporary registered nurse license. This license had an expiration date of 3/11/03.

6. Respondent began employment with University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics on December 16, 2002.
7. Respondent practiced as a registered nurse from March 11, 2003 until February 25, 2004 without a valid license.
8. Respondent received her registered nurse license on March 8, 2004.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. Respondent, by practicing professional nursing without a current license, violated Wis. Admin. Code § 5.03(1); has committed misconduct and unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.04(15).
3. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has the authority, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.22, to assess the costs of this proceeding against the Respondent.

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The license of Jodi L. Roll, to practice as registered nurse in the State of Wisconsin is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of three hundred sixty-four (\$364.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit any payment of the costs as ordered the Respondent's license(#143030) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
4. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
