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5. Dr. Hockman, while neither admitting nor denying the allegations agrees to voluntarily surrender her license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin and not to reapply for licensure in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02.
2. The Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the voluntary surrender of the license of Sheila F. Hockman D.O. to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin is hereby accepted effective on the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Sheila F. Hockman D.O. shall not reapply for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is effective on the date of its signing.
