PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Sharon Christine Roback (D.O.B. 2/1/68) is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a practical nurse (license #34608). This license was first granted on 3/6/98.
2. On 12/5/06, Respondent submitted a sample of urine from her body, which was positive for cocaine and its metabolites. Respondent did not have a prescription or other authority to ingest this substance. Respondent used cocaine non-medically on two other occasions, in January, 2007.
3. An AODA assessment by a qualified person found that Respondent's use of cocaine was a response to depression and did not represent chemical dependence. Respondent has sought and received medical assistance for her depression, and represents to the Board that she has not used cocaine or any other illicit substance since January, 2007.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

By the conduct described above, respondent is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(b), (c) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code §§ N 7.03(1)(a), (b), (c), (e), and N 7.04(1) and (15).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Sharon C. Roback, L.P.N., is REPRIMANDED for her unprofessional conduct in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent shall not consume any controlled substance listed in Schedule I-IV, without a valid prescription of an authorized prescriber, and for a valid medical purpose. Respondent shall, upon request of the Board or its designee, or the Department, or an investigator thereof (including a law enforcement officer, acting at the request of the Board or its designee, the Department, or an investigator thereof), submit a sample of Respondent's blood, urine, breath, and/or hair (as designated by the requesting person) for analysis, forthwith upon such request. This shall not be deemed a limitation upon Respondent's license, but failure to comply is a violation of an Order of the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall pay the costs of investigating and prosecuting this matter, in the amount of \$600, no later than 4/5/09. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit full payment of costs, the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has paid the costs in full, together with any accrued interest.
