### **PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Board (“Board”). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation in this matter and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology establishment having license number 80-29303. This license was first granted to it on August 7, 2000. M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters’ most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing (“Department”) is 3524 E. Layton Ave., Cudahy, WI 53110.

2. Mary Kay Hauke is the owner of M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters. Ms. Hauke was and is responsible for compliance with chapter 454 of the Wisconsin Statutes and chapter BC 4 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

3. On February 15, 2008, Departmental Investigator Douglas Austin conducted an inspection of M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters. The inspection revealed violations of sections BC 4.01 (1) and BC 4.02 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and Mr. Austin issued two barbering and cosmetology citations to M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters. Each citation carried a forfeiture and costs of \$130. Mr. Austin noted and explained, but did not issue citations for, a number of other practice areas.

4. In resolution of this matter, Mary Kay Hauke consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to section 454.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to sec. 227.44(5), Wis. Stats.
2. Respondent M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters is subject to discipline for the violations in Finding of Fact 3 above.

## ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Respondent, M.K. Kreiers Hair Quarters, shall pay the forfeiture and costs of \$260.00 as follows:

The Respondent shall pay no less than \$52.00 within 30 days after the date of this Order, with additional payments of \$52.00 due monthly until the total of \$260.00 is paid.

In the event that the Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as set forth above, its Barbering and Cosmetology establishment license **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of the forfeiture and costs has been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that file 08 BAC 081 be closed.
