The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on October 29, 2008.

BACKGROUND

On January 13, 1999, based upon a Stipulation signed by Mr. Iverson, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Mr. Iverson's license to practice as a pharmacist for a period of not less than 5 years. In its Order, the Board stayed the suspension of Mr. Iverson's license for a period of 3 months, subject to his complying with numerous conditions and limitations. The Order also provides that the Board, in its discretion, may restore Mr. Iverson's license to full, unlimited status only upon petition by Mr. Iverson after completion of five years of practice of pharmacy in compliance with all terms and condition of the Order, and a demonstration that he may practice pharmacy without condition or limitation with skill and safety to patient and public. At various times between January 13, 1999 and April 4, 2008, the Board stayed the suspension of Mr. Iverson's license; denied his requests for the stay of suspension of his license and denied his request for the reinstatement.

On or about October 7, 2008, Mr. Iverson requested a stay of suspension of his license. The Board considered Mr. Iverson's request for a stay of suspension at its meeting on October 29, 2008. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license (#8239) of Roger G. Iverson to practice as a pharmacist is stayed for a period of three (3) months conditioned upon his compliance with the conditions and limitations set forth in paragraph 2 of the Order contained in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated January 13, 1999.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. The Board, in its discretion, may restore Mr. Iverson's license to full, unlimited status only upon petition by Mr. Iverson after completion of five (5) years of practice of pharmacy, subsequent to the date of this stay of suspension Order, in compliance with all terms and conditions of the Order set forth in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated January 13, 1999, and a demonstration that he may practice pharmacy without condition or limitation with skill and safety to patient and public.

2. The Order contained in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated January 13, 1999 shall remain in effect.

This order is effective on the date it is signed by a designee of the Board.
