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The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on June 24, 2009.

BACKGROUND

On October 19, 2005, based upon a Stipulation signed by Mr. Kunde, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Mr. Kunde's license to practice as a pharmacist for an indefinite period of time. The Order provided that the suspension shall be stayed upon Mr. Kunde providing proof of compliance with the provisions contained in Sections C and D of the Order, and that his treater is of the opinion that he is able to safely practice pharmacy under the restrictions contained in the Order. At various times since the effective date of the Order, the Board granted stays of suspension of Mr. Kunde's pharmacist license.

On or about June 3, 2009, Mr. Kunde requested a reduction in his random drug screens from seventy-two (72) times per year to forty-eight (48) times per year. The Board considered Mr. Kunde's modification request at its meeting on June 24, 2009. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the license (#8830-40) of Robert J. Kunde to practice as a pharmacist is continuously stayed for an indefinite period, conditioned upon his compliance with the conditions and limitations set forth in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated October 19, 2005.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Mr. Kunde's request for reduction of his random drug screens from seventy-two (72) times per year to forty-eight (48) times per year, be, and hereby is, granted.

The effective date of this Order is June 24, 2009.
