PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Stipulation comes after the issuance of a barbering and cosmetology citation. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lynne’s Scizzory is a duly licensed barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin having license #080-29448. This license was first granted on 11/3/00.
2. Lynne’s Scizzory’s last known reported business address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing (“Department”) is: 4245 S. Packard Avenue, St. Francis, Wisconsin 53235.
3. At all times relevant to the facts stated below, Lynne’s Scizzory was responsible for compliance with BC chapter 4 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
4. On or about February 15, 2008, an inspection of Lynne’s Scizzory was conducted by a Department consumer protection investigator. The inspection revealed that the salon’s barbicide disinfectant was not being changed on a daily basis.
5. A barbering and cosmetology citation was issued to the management of Lynne’s Scizzory in regards to the

violation found during the inspection.

6. Mrs. Lynne Canzoneri Bartholomew (owner, licensed barber/cosmetology instructor, and licensed barber/cosmetology manager of Lynne's Scizzory) related to the Department that she is willing to accept responsibility for the citation; however, wants it to be reflected that she was not aware of the rules on changing disinfectant on a daily basis.

7. In resolution of this matter, Lynne's Scizzory consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 454.15, and the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct referred to in the above Findings of Fact, Lynne's Scizzory has violated:
Wis. Admin. Code § BC 4.02(5) by failing to change disinfectant on a daily basis as defined in § BC 1.01(6) of the Code.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent, Lynne's Scizzory shall pay a FORFEITURE AND COSTS of ONE HUNDRED THIRTY dollars (\$130.00) within thirty (30) days of the dating and signing of this ORDER.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event that if the Respondent, Lynne's Scizzory fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as set forth above, Lynne Scizzory's, barbering and cosmetology manager's license #080 0029448 **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further hearing and without further Order of the Board, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said partial costs has been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and their failure to pay the costs shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file, 08 BAC 037 be, and hereby is, closed as to the Respondent.
