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3. Respondent represented to the Board's investigator that some two days before the test, she was a passenger in a vehicle on a journey of several hours, when the driver permitted others to smoke marijuana, but that she did not herself accept or smoke any.

4. The Medical Review Officer (physician) for the testing laboratory has informed the Board that Respondent's THC level was 119 ng/ml, and that this level is inconsistent with Respondent's account. A person whose exposure was limited to inhaling second-hand smoke as Respondent states, would typically have a THC level of 1-5 ng/ml.

### CONCLUSION OF LAW

By the conduct described above, respondent is subject to disciplinary action against her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(b) and (d), and Wis. Adm. Code § N 7.04(1), (2), and (15).

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that :

1. Angela M. Crape, R.N, is REPRIMANDED for her unprofessional conduct in this matter.
2. Respondent shall, upon request of the Board or its designee, or any agent of the Board or its designee (which may include a law enforcement officer) provide a sample of her breath, blood, urine, or hair for testing. This provision shall not be deemed a limitation on Respondent's license, but violation shall be subject to action pursuant to par. 3, below.
3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall pay the costs of investigating and prosecuting this matter, in the amount of \$1,050, no later than 1/5/12. If not paid, Respondent's license shall be SUSPENDED without further notice or hearing, until they are paid in full, together with any accrued interest.
