PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 16, 2015, the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) Division of Legal Services and Compliance (Division) commenced investigations into allegations of medical incompetence, negligence in treatment and unprofessional conduct arising out of two separate incidents involving Respondent.

In case number 15 MED 150, Respondent is alleged to have caused or contributed to the death of a two year old child who suffered severe burns from scalding water over a number of areas on his body. In case number 15 MED 151, Respondent's alleged incompetence and/or negligence was said to have caused or contributed to the death of a laboring mother and her unborn child. Both investigations are ongoing.

The parties have agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as an Interim Order in this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Interim Order In the matter of disciplinary proceedings against Troy D. Schrock, D.O., Case Nos. 15 MED 150 and 15 MED 151

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Troy D. Schrock, D.O. (dob March 25, 1976), is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 49460-21, first issued on July 10, 2006, with registration current through February 29, 2016. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 102 E. 2nd Street, Unity, Wisconsin 54488.

2. Respondent's practice specialty is family medicine. He holds no board certifications and has no prior disciplinary history with the Department.

3. At all times pertinent to this matter Respondent was self-employed as a sole practitioner at Country Health Clinic located in Unity, Wisconsin.

4. The Board opened case number 15 MED 150 to investigate the Respondent's care and treatment of a toddler who died within days of suffering burns from scalding water.

5. The Board opened case number 15 MED 151 to investigate the Respondent's care and treatment of a laboring mother and her unborn child, both of whom died following complications during delivery.

6. Respondent neither admits nor denies failing to meet any professional standard of care, and further denies engaging in unprofessional conduct or negligence in treatment in relation to his care and treatment of the afore-mentioned patients. The investigation into both matters has only recently commenced; the cases are unresolved and remain, as yet, unproven in any public forum.

7. Respondent wishes to fully cooperate with the Board's investigation, and as a measure of good faith, voluntarily agrees to limit his practice by consenting to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Interim Order.

8. The parties may at any time, by stipulated agreement, petition the Board to rescind or amend the terms of this Interim Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

INTERIM ORDER

1. The Stipulation of the parties is accepted.

Interim Order In the matter of disciplinary proceedings against Troy D. Schrock, D.O., Case Nos. 15 MED 150 and 15 MED 151

2. In accordance with Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3)(e), the license to practice medicine and surgery issued to Respondent, Troy D. Schrock, D.O. (license no. 49460-21), is LIMITED/RESTRICTED subject to the following terms and conditions during the pendency of this action:

3. Respondent may see patients under the age of sixteen who suffer from burns (water, fire, chemical or electrical) in order to perform a preliminary examination and/or diagnose the severity of the burns.

4. Respondent shall not take on the care and treatment of any children under the age of sixteen suffering from and/or requiring treatment for burns more significant than first-degree burns.

5. Respondent shall immediately, but no later than 30 days of the date of this Order, transfer responsibility for care and treatment of any current patient under the age of sixteen who suffers from and/or requires treatment for burns more severe than first-degree.

6. Respondent shall not schedule or attempt to perform delivery of an obstetric patient in his clinic unless another licensed physician who is qualified to provide obstetrical services is present or immediately available within a 20 mile radius of Respondent's clinic location.

7. Respondent shall not take on any new obstetric patients beyond their first trimester of pregnancy.

8. Respondent shall immediately, but no later than 30 days of the date of this Order transfer the care of any current obstetric patient in her third-trimester of pregnancy to another qualified health care professional.

9. Respondent shall not administer intravenous sedation drugs to any adult patient unless and until he and/or members of his staff are trained and qualified to perform intubation on adult patients, and have the equipment and supplies necessary to do so safely.

10. Respondent shall immediately, but no later than 30 days of the date of this Order, ensure that he and/or members of his staff are adequately trained and certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

11. This Order is effective upon the date of its signing.

Respondent Troy D. Schrock, D.O., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of pending investigations by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the entry of this Interim Order.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights with regard to a Petition for Summary Suspension:

- the right to a show cause hearing;
- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. The parties know, understand, and agree, that by entering into this stipulated agreement, Respondent retains all rights attendant to final resolution of this matter.

4. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney William Bauer.

5. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations in these matters, but agrees to the adoption of the attached Interim Order by the Medical Examining Board. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Interim Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

Stipulation In the matter of disciplinary proceedings against Troy D. Schrock, D.O., Case Nos. 15 MED 150 and 15 MED 151

6. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and these matters shall be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

7. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as a case advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, if any, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with the Board's deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such case advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Interim Order.

8. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation; the Board's Interim Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

9. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending that the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Interim Order.
