FINDINGS OF FACT  
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW  
AND ORDER  
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This action coming on to be heard before the Architects' Section of The Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors on the 30th day of April, 1976, pursuant to notice duly given on complaint of the Division of Safety and Buildings, State of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, in support of said complaint and a motion for an order in default having been presented by William Dusso, staff attorney for said Board, and the respondent, Gerald E. Mundt, having been served with complaint, notice of hearing and motion for default but respondent having failed to file an answer in the required form or to defend or make any appearance in the above entitled action and Gordon Samuelsen and Lowell E. Nass, Assistant Attorneys General, being present to advise the Architects' Section and the Architects' Section having heard the evidence and being advised in the premises, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

(1) That Gerald E. Mundt, whose address is 4212 Poplar Drive, Minneapolis, Minnesota, is, and was at all times hereinafter mentioned, licensed by the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors, pursuant to the provisions of s. 443.01, Wis. Stats., as an architect, holding Certificate No. A-3127;

(2) That on July 31, 1975, the Division of Safety and Buildings, State of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, (hereinafter "Division") conducted a building inspection of the Havenet Nursing Home located in Owen, Wisconsin, and determined that the building was in the process of being altered according to the plans prepared by respondent;

(3) That said alterations eliminated from the second floor of the building an exit required by the Wisconsin Building Code;

(4) That plans for alterations to Havenet Nursing Home had not been submitted by respondent to the Division for review prior to July 31, 1975;

(5) That respondent was ordered by the Division to submit to the Division plans and specifications showing building alterations and that said plans were received by the Division on August 11, 1975;

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

(1) That respondent's failure to submit plans to the Division for review prior to altering the Havenet Nursing Home as required by Wis. Adm. Code ss. IND 50.10 and 52.001 violates Wis. Adm. Code s. A-E 4.06, a rule of professional conduct of the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors;

#### ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is ordered that the Certificate of Registration as an Architect, No. A-3127, of Gerald E.

Mundt, respondent, shall be and hereby is suspended for a period of 30 days, said suspension to take effect on the 30th day following service of this Order on respondent provided, however, that this Board may for good cause, on petition of respondent if filed within 30 days of service of this Order, relieve respondent from the effect of this Order and permit respondent to answer and defend.
