

COMPLAINT

The Division of Safety and Buildings, State of Wisconsin, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, by its Chief Engineer, Ergun I. Somersan, alleges as follows:

- 1) That Ergun I. Somersan is the Chief Engineer of the Division of Safety and Buildings, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, an agency of the State of Wisconsin and is authorized to complain on behalf of said Division in his capacity as Chief Engineer;
- 2) That the post office address of the Division of Safety and Buildings, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations is 201 East Washington Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin, 53702;
- 3) On information and belief, that Gerald E. Mundt, whose address is 4212 Poplar Drive, Minneapolis, Minnesota, is, and was at all times hereinafter mentioned, licensed by the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors, pursuant to the provisions of s. 443.01, Wisconsin Statutes, as an architect, holding Certificate No. A-3127;
- 4) That on July 31, 1975, the Division of Safety and Buildings (hereinafter "Division") conducted a building inspection of the Havenet Nursing Home located in Owen, Wisconsin and determined that the building was in the process of being altered according to plans prepared by respondent;
- 5) That said alterations eliminated from the second floor of the building an exit required by the Wisconsin Building Code;
- 6) That plans for alterations to Havenet Nursing Home had not been submitted by respondent to the Division for review prior to July 31, 1975:
- 7) That respondent was ordered by the Division to submit to the Division plans and specifications showing building alterations and that said plans were received by the Division on August 11, 1975;

8. That respondent's failure to submit plans to the Division for review prior to altering the Havenet Nursing Home as required by Wis. Adm. Code ss. IND 50.10 and 52.001 violates Wis. Adm. Code s. A-E 4.06, a rule of professional conduct of the Examining Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors;
