The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board having met on August 9, 1984,
and having received and considered a STIPULATION, a copy of which is
attached hereto and incorporated herein;

And the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board having determined that it has
jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stats. sec. 448.02(5);

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The terms of the attached STIPULATION are approved and adopted
by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board.


2. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board accepts the voluntary
surrender of Glen M. Tucker's license to practice medicine and surgery in
the State of Wisconsin, license #17075.

3. Glen M. Tucker shall not practice or attempt to practice medicine
and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future, and shall
not make re-application for a license to practice medicine and surgery in
the State of Wisconsin.

4. Pending investigations #84 MED 49 and #84 MED 134 shall be
terminated and no formal complaints shall be issued.
